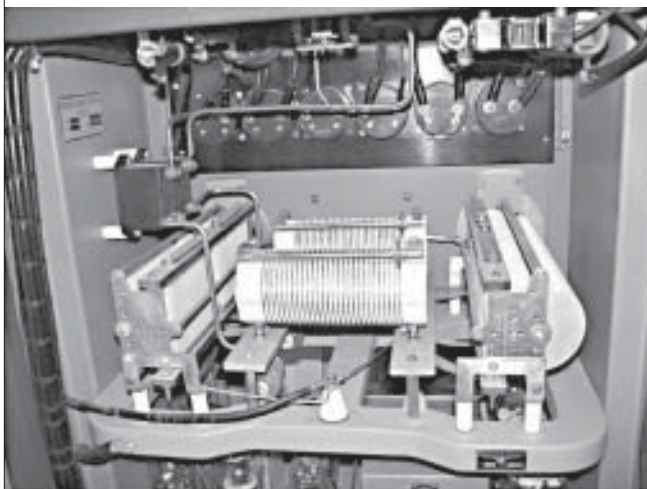

Collins 30J Parts Needed!

I am willing to pay big bucks for the right parts! For restoration of a Collins 30J transmitter (circa 1940) suitable parts are needed, especially for the RF output deck. As a reference, the photo below shows the RF output deck of a restored Collins 30J. I need to get many of the parts shown, such as the following items: capacitors, inductors, dial assemblies, and support structures. Parts include a Cardwell variable, 440 pf max per section with the same physical dimensions below, 4 capacitor mounting brackets, straps for the Cardwell



capacitors, mica transmitting capacitors (2000 pf, 6kV), ball handle toggle switches, ceramic coil form 2.5" OD, silver plated #16 AWG wire, Collins (or similar) tuning coil cans, correct tube shields, RF ammeter, 2.5 to 3 amps.
